Today's Message Notes . . . 'Early Church Distinctives'

The Four Distinctives of the Church

Acts 2:40-47

C. Third Distinctive - Worship

Acts 2:42 – breaking of bread

a. What?

- The Lord's supper is meant here - Acts 20:7
- A remembrance/recognition or adoration for what He did
 - We need to remember why he died?
 - We should also remember HOW he died.
- A looking forward to the time he will return
 - Notice the terms UNWORTHY

b. Where?

- From house to house - Location wasn't important - Heart was the matter!

Worship defined – definition defines function!

- kissing of the hand – A bowing of the knee - WORTHSHIP

John 4:19-24

V:20 – Our fathers worshiped – She was saying that her worship was OK and the way of worship simply because it was passed down by their fathers

- We perpetuate many errors simply because our fathers did it

V. 21-24 - Jesus answers in 3 parts:

1. The Father – Worship is no longer centered around a place
Worship is of the Father who is Spirit
2. In Spirit – worship is no longer about a form but of the spirit of worship
Phil. 3:3; Ezekiel 11:19
3. In Truth - Worship is no longer about ritual but about heart and life of worship
Romans 12:1
 - Present – to stand beside – picture of standing before God as a living sacrifice
 - **Holy and acceptable – was does this mean to you?**

Jesus says that God is seeking those who will worship this way:

- God is looking and listening
- God is seeking your worship

But your worship must be out of a changed heart and a life lived
