

Pray, Fight, Build

Nehemiah 4:13-23

A practical guide from Nehemiah to building and fighting for the Kingdom and God's GLORY

Therefore:

- Could have done nothing
- Could have panicked

He Developed a Strategic Battle Plan

1. Protect the openings v. 13,14
2. Families are a PRIORITY v 14
3. DO NOT FEAR v 14
4. There is a time for battle and a time for work v 15
5. Battle Readiness for EVERYONE is a necessity
6. All of us must be prepared for the battle and the work v 17,18
7. Leaders must be the support of everyone v16
8. We must watch out for each other v 19-20
9. Vigilance never ends V 21-22
10. We must keep our clothes on v 23

As we stay involved in this ever-present battle we must be clothed with two things to ensure victory:

I. **Clothed in the Righteousness of Christ**

- Isa 61:10; Rom 3:21, 22; Gal 3:26, 27

II. **Clothed in the Armor of God - Eph 6:10-20**

- A. Be Strong in the LORD and the POWER of His MIGHT
 1. Power
 2. Might
- B. Put on the WHOLE armor of God
- C. Principalities and Powers
 1. There is a LIMIT to their power Romans 8:38,39
 2. Jesus has the AUTHORITY of them Eph 1:20-23; Col 1:16; 2:10
 3. God has a PURPOSE in allowing their work Eph 3:10,11; I Cor 15:24
 4. Our victory is rooted in what Jesus DID, **not in what we do.** Col 2:15
