Luke 5:1-11

### I. When the Routine gets Routine

- A. Peter's routine –
- B. Do you feel like this sometimes?
- C. This is not a healthy place for the believer

### II. A fresh outlook starts by breaking routine and listening to God

- A. Peter broke away from what he knew needed to be done to keep up with the routine
- B. We must break away from the routine and sit down to listen
  - 1. Ask
  - 2. Pray about it

### III. Simple Obedience brings blessing/harvest

- A. Peter's empty experience
  - 1. Hard work
  - 2. All night
  - 3. No fish
- B. The reward of simple obedience
  - Peter decided to obey – Row out drop the nets in a place where we
  - Obedience brings blessing Deuteronomy 28, Luke 11:28
