Confronted by Holiness Holiness of God Part 4 Isa. 6:1-7

Introduction: God has been defanged in our world and in the church.

Popular Blog: "Christians have defanged their own god, who became a much nicer benevolent individual"

I. Isaiah's confrontation

- He is confronted with God's Holiness
- The scriptural norm in response to this confrontation
 - Job 42:6; Ezra 9:5; Luke 5:8; John 18:6
- In our context Isaiah is a righteous man yet when confronted he cries out "WOE is me for I am UNDONE
- Oracle of Woe

- Undone – disintegration

****The standard is God's Holiness – not the church and not the world – and when we stand under that standard we always fail! ****

II. Isaiah's Confession

- I am a man of unclean lips
- The mouth delivers what's in the heart Matt 12:33-37; 15:10-20

**** We have learned to justify every sin we commit as if it is not harmful to us or the holiness of the God we claim to belong to. ****

III. God's response

- In some religious arenas there are several possibilities:
 - Oh that's OK...
 - Suffer you sinning creep...
- Here God responds with grace and mercy to Isaiah
 - Fiery coal
 - Placed on the lips
 - Purify them for the message from God

**** When God deals with our sin, the GUILT is gone and the sin is ATONED! ****

Our response: Isa 1:18-20

When was the last time we truly came before our Holy God and confessed and repented of our sin?
