answering the call for missionaries, beginning in SE Asia. CBM works always in partnership with the local and regional church, focused particularly on training of pastors and leaders, and on ministry in the workplace.

**CCC supports two couples – Tim & Kallie Hutton, Cochabamba Bolivia; Bill & Janice Dyck, Central and South America, stationed in Calgary.** Tim teaches & works with the library at the Bolivian Baptist

Seminary, Kallie supports women's ministries and the children's CASA de la Amistad Centre for street children. Bill Dyck leads pastoral training and support for pastors from a number of evangelical denominations, in person and online. Janice works online and in person with children at the CASA through her gift of music teaching.

**An estimated 608,000 - 1 million people have been internally displaced in Lebanon as they flee areas targeted by airstrikes – that is up to 1 in 5 people. This (includes) many of the estimated 1.5 million Syrian refugees that Lebanon is already hosting, the largest number of refugees per capita in the world.**

**CBM is responding through our partners ABTS and Thimar in Lebanon.** Dorm rooms at the seminary and spaces for worship are now shelters to provide temporary accommodation for multiple households. Essential items like blankets, pillows, feminine pads, diapers, toiletries, and emergency lights are being distributed, but **needs will continue beyond the resources currently available.**
