Dying to Live Sermon on the Mount Pt 9

Matt 6:16-34

Where is your heart?

- Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth
 - This is not a statement against saving but about stewardship
- Lay up treasures in heaven
- Wherever you find your treasure is where you will find your heart
 - In the non-crucified life (SELF driven life) the focus is on comforts and accounts
 - In the crucified life (Christ driven life) the focus is Kingdom
 - Phil 4:10-19

Where are your eyes?

- What are your values based on?
- IF your eyes are fixated on the temporal and evil of the world then your whole life reflects it
- If your eyes are on the glory of God and light then your whole life reflects it.

Who's your Master?

- It is impossible to serve two masters at the same time
 - who do you worship? God or money
 - Serve/Slave I Cor 6:19,20; Romans 6:16
 - The result is frustration and mixed allegiances

Where is your FAITH?

- Therefore - The two are intrinsically connected – don't be a slave to money, give it away, don't kill yourself to have it then you have to worry about where all the stuff is going to come from
- Jesus says "TAKE NO THOUGHT" or "DO NOT BE WORRIED (ANXIOUS)"
 - Disquieted mind
- This is not an admonishment to carelessness
- This is not a promise to never be in need - 2 Cor 11:27; Hebrews 11:36-37
- Three reasons why we do not have to be anxious
 1. You are a child of the King
 2. Your Father KNOWS what you need
 3. Tomorrow is not here
- What do You Seek?
 - HERE IS THE KEY TO THE WHOLE SECTION
 - When your priority is HERE there is no need for anxiety
