For over 40 years CBM has 'SENT' individuals and teams from Canada to visit our global partners. Put on hold in March 2020 due to the pandemic, we are excited to be planning SENT experiences again for 2023. *CBM sends teams to Cuba, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Bolivia, El Salvador, Lebanon, India, Rwanda, Kenya, Thailand, Germany and the Philippines. Most trips are between 10-14 days, but longer experiences are also available, including up to 1 year.* No two SENT trips are the same, but you can expect to visit CBM's partner churches and field staff and join God in the work being done through the local church.
