# Today's Message Notes . . .

## Message - Pastor Donny

### I. The Central Message of the Bible – the Gospel

I Corinthians 15:1-4

- It is the theme throughout the whole of OT:
- In the NT it is emphasized

### II. Our Reasonable Life of WORSHIP

Romans 12:1,2

#### 1. The Cross (Gospel) the APEX of God's mercy

- The sacrifice of the cross was a PROPITIATORY sacrifice –
  - I Peter 2:24
- It is here – the death of Jesus – the CROSS - and only here that God's justice could be satisfied

#### 2. Our reasonable response is a life lived to honor/give thanks for this mercy

- This is an offering of thanksgiving (dedicatory) for the propitiation
- Our reasonable response to the MERCY of God is this life of WORSHIP
- We go back to Ephesians 4 and our word PUT AWAY
  - Passive voice – meaning it is by an outside force
- IT IS ABOUT ENABLEMENT FIRST
  - Col 3:1-4 seek above mind above THEN Col. 3:5-11
  - Galatians 5 – walk in the spirit FIRST then you will not fulfill the lust of the flesh
- We must have a heart that is aligned with the purposes and activities of God

**\*\*\* WHEN we have these inverted we will FAIL \*\*\* we lose the power of the gospel!**

Practical Application:

**#1- For this you have nothing to boast of!**

**#2 - Compels us to give ourselves away**

**#3 – Experience of the Gospel will untie your tongue**

**#4 – The gospel will always remind us from where we came**
