Today's Message Notes . . .

Saying a Godly No

Nehemiah 5:14-6:14

Intro: Just say no campaign taught our kids to say no to drugs. Now they are taught to say yes to most things that were appalling when the drug campaign was running. We need to say no with the right heart to the right things and for the right reasons. Nehemiah was a yes and no man.

I. The Heart of the person who says a Godly NO

1. Has a healthy **Fear** of God 5:15
 - Wonder, respect, awe, fear
 - God's glory is of the utmost priority
 - Ecc. 12:13; Duet. 10:12-22
2. Is directed by **Compassion** 5:18
 - Compassion is seen in action Mark 6:30-34
3. Lives in **Humility** 5:16
 - It is seen in his actions - Not above the work 5:16
 - It is seen in his prayers – dependence on God 5:19; 6:9, 14
4. Being watchful (vigilant) to see what is contrary to God 6:1-9
 - Trusting God never frees us from being vigilant – Acts 20:31
 - Be alert to the things that will not bring Glory to God

II. Saying a Godly NO

1. Saying no to **Privilege** 5:14
 - He was rich but his riches did not have him
2. Saying no to **Proposals** 6:3
 - What does this have to do with God's work?
 - Prioritize:
 - o Glory of God
 - o Church purpose – discipleship, evangelism, missions
 - o Family – Children Mark 10:13-16
3. Saying no to **Panic (Fear)**
 - Absolute trust in the purpose/call of God
 - Be like Nehemiah – stand firm, not driven by fear of threats
 - We will not be intimidated

(Reflections from a father of a newborn on the food gifts of family and friends – Faithtoday.ca 01/02/23 P.37) "...Living by *manna* (Israel called its own unexpected sustenance, their heavenly bread, 'manna') is more difficult than it seems. On the one hand we receive it as a divine gift. On the other, we must sacrifice *The Plan...our attempt to control our present and the future...* When God commands us to take a rest, a sabbath, he invites us to set aside *The Plan*." Accepting the gift of food when we need a sabbath requires trusting God's provisions - especially if you are a parent of young children!
