**Distinctive #4 Prayer Pt 3**

**I. We need a renewed high view of God**

SO why do we not do this. We have a LOW VIEW of God

1. Intentional unrepented Sin
2. Pride Job 42:1-6; Daniel 4:34,35
3. Worry Philippians 4:6 Matthew 6 25-34

**We fear, worry or become anxious that God is not wise enough, strong enough, or good enough to do what is best or even what we ask.**

**II. LOW VIEW vs. HIGH VIEW**

- Big God, big answers; little God....
- A high view of God says:
  - o We will maintain a high view even when God doesn't do what I ask
  - o We will maintain a high view of God when man (church) hurts us
- A my (low) view of God says
  - o He doesn't consider my prayer – HIGH VIEW –
  - o He is silent HIGH VIEW –
  - o He is willing to let me suffer HIGH VIEW –

**WARNING:** Be careful your discovery of God's bigness doesn't cause you to take a fatalistic view of prayer

**III. Prayer as Intimacy with God**

- Prayer must be more than request Psalm 63:1-8
- Drawing close has the idea of expression of your joy, your love your desire to draw near.
- James 4:8 says Draw near to God and He will draw near to you
- Jesus in the alone times???
  - o Luke 5:16; Matthew 14:23; Mark 1:35; Luke 6:12; Luke 9:18
- Paul and Silas Acts 16: 24-26

Challenge: Do you pray always? Do you pray with fervency? Do you pray at all?  
Do you live in worry and anxiousness when things aren't going well?  
Do you go to God just to have intimacy, a drawing near?
