Today's Notes . . . June 16th, 2024 – Pastor Donny

Motivation is an internal state that propels individuals to engage in goal-directed behavior.

- Intrinsic motivation or Extrinsic motivation

Jesus begins this section of his sermon on the mount by warning the disciples about the motivation behind the righteous acts of his followers. What is your motive for doing the things you do?

Motivation is the Glory of God 6:1

- Don't do this to be seen by others - This is not a contradiction 5:16
- 1 Corinthians 4:5 - Motives will be revealed! And God will praise the correct motives – all else will be stubble

Warning 6:1

The first verse starts with a warning – TAKE HEED – or BEWARE

- Why start with this warning?
 - o Jeremiah 17:9; Eccl 9:3

He gives the warning in three major practices of the Jews at the time 6:1-18

1. Giving

- Give with the right motive - we do secretly God will reward openly

2. Prayer

- Where to pray
- How to Pray
 - o Not with babbling
 - o Pray like this
 - o Discipline, Spontaneity and freedom - self righteousness or worship?
- Prayerlessness
 - o Pride – I got this
 - o Lack of faith – The Prayer Train
 - Prayer is the train; Faith is the engine; God's promises are the fuel source; Discipline is the tracks/rails

**** Prayerlessness is almost always due to a STALLED ENGINE ****

- Rails are useless if there is not POWER
- The heart of Prayer
 - a. Forgiveness
