Dying to Live #4

John 3:22-30

November 5th, 2023

Self-life and its motivation must die and ALL of life must become motivated by the will of the Father

- Jesus says I have come ONLY to do the will of the Father

*****To what or to whom you submit yourself to will control you*****

Jesus First

Example of John the Baptist

1. John's purpose John 1:6-8; 14-16; 19-34
2. His followers come and complain
3. John's Confession John 3:30 –

He MUST INCREASE I MUST DECREASE!

1. He must increase – be moved to the forefront
2. I must decrease – moved to the back

Ultimate Result of John's confession was his jailing and death

King Jesus John 12:12-19

- John 6 – Jesus refuses to be made King
- John 12:12-19 – Jesus fulfills it (His time has come)
- The world has gone after Him! 12:19 1 Kings 8:41-43
- Greeks come to see Him 12:20
- Jesus is King of Israel, King of the World and He is YOUR KING!!

Cost and Blessing of following the King 12:20-26

- We want to SEE Jesus –
- Jesus response: This is what you will see! I have to die to bear fruit!

"Jesus' death for our salvation becomes our design for imitation" (John Piper)

- Transitions to His followers (that's us!)

Cost:

1. Die to self-mastery - a daily experience! 12:24
2. Hate (love less than Me) your life in THIS WORLD 12:25
3. Follow me (to Calvary!) on path to death 12:26a
4. Serve me – being a servant in a world of power HARD! 12:26b

Blessing - The cost is not to the detriment of your JOY on this life!!

1. Die – Bear much fruit John 15 12:24
2. Gain ETERNAL life II Cor 4:17 12:25
3. When we follow we are WITH HIM!! John 14:3 12:26a
4. The HONOR of the Father Luke 12:37 12:26b
