## ***Sermon Notes Today January 19<sup>th</sup> Pastor Donny***

REVIEW:

A. First distinctive of the church: They were a church of the Word of God

B. Second distinctive of the church: They were a **fellowshipping** church

### **C. Third Distinctive - Worship**

Acts 2:42 – breaking of bread I Cor 11:23-29

- Remember – a continuous recalling –
- This REMEMBERING is not just a recalling of facts – it is a **participation** in the reality of what Jesus has done for us – it is how we WORSHIP!  
I Cor 10:16
- AND THIS deserves/demands OUR worship – all of it!

**\*\* If we do not see communion as an act of worship then we are only going through a ritual – this is no better example than the Pharisees in Jesus day \*\***

**Worship defined** – definition defines function!

- NT- towards and kiss- A bowing of the knee – in admiration adoration

### **1. Comes from the redeemed heart of a person who has been justified by God and trusting Jesus alone for the forgiveness of their sins**

- There is no worship from an unredeemed, unclean heart Ezek 11:19
- Therefore if we want to truly worship God it begins with a bowing of the knee and the heart
  - o I am lost - I need a savior - Jesus is the answer

### **2. Once redeemed worship must come from a heart that desires to worship only God**

- My spiritual affection is for Him only.
- 2 Kings 17:28-41

### **3. When our affections are towards God then our life instinctively follows**

- True worship involves both the inward and outward of the person
- Romans 12:1
- Present – to stand beside hence to place at someone's disposal
- Holy and acceptable – what does this mean to you?
  - o Holy – separated - consecrated
  - o Acceptable means well pleasing
- Which is your reasonable worship

Our form of worship, post-resurrection, is to bring ourselves, our own lives, as a living sacrifice to God. This is holy and pleasing to Him
