Today's Scripture & Message:

God's Chisel...ouch! How do I handle it? Galatians 5:16 – 6:5

- Revival never begins with the healthy but broken people.
- This often comes in the form of exposure of our own sinfulness.
- This is not a pleasant or enjoyable experience.

CAUTION: Be careful that we do not become victims of the Liar and murderer himself – Satan John 8:44

- Guilt and condemnation results in shame. Shame results in staying away from intimacy with God

To the One who is experiencing this process now:

1. Remember he Loves you just like you are but in His love refuses to allow you to remain as you are
2. You are not alone in this struggle.
 - Galatians 5:17; Romans 7:23-25
3. This doe NOT make it OK to continue the way you have
 - Galatians 5:25 – Practical Christianity
4. Respond by HUMILITY and SUBMISSION
 - James 4:5-10
5. Have FAITH in the TRUTH
