# Today's Message Notes . . .

Goodness of God PT 2

Nehemiah 9:6-15

We can see the goodness of God in the historical recollection in the following ways:

## I. Creative Power

### II. Sovereign Power

- You ARE the LORD God –
- LORD – Jehovah
- God – Elohim –
- It means that He is SUPERIOR to any other gods in POWER, STRENGTH AND AUTHORITY
- Isaiah 46:8-11 - I am God and there is no other
- In His sovereignty God ELECTED - chose Abram
  - o Who was Abram from all others? Idol worshiper
  - o What about you? Did you do something to deserve the GRACE of God in choosing?
- God looks to have a people who are his very own – AND he CHOSE YOU! Because God is GOOD!

### III. Redemptive Power

- Saw the affliction and heard the cry
  - o Eph 2:12 He saw our need and responded by sending Christ
- Showed His power to the enemy and made a name for Yourself 9:10, 11
  - o Col 2:15
- Made a way in the sea
  - o Colossians 1:13
- Led them by cloud and by fire day/night
  - o Always Assured that God was present – cloud and fire – Holy Spirit
  - o John 14:15-17; 26; John 15:7,13,14
- God spoke to them and gave them His law
  - o It was not all joy but He gave the law with expectation of them following and a reward of “going well”
  - o Duet 6:2,3; Proverbs 3:1, 2; II Timothy 3:14-17
- God Himself provided their sustenance – bread and water
  - o Matthew 4:4; Duet 8:3
  - o Find our satisfaction, delight in Him – to savor Him above all else
  - o Nehemiah 8:10 The JOY of the Lord is my strength!
