Message - Pastor Donny The CBA's of Nehemiah 1:1-4

- I. Nehemiah was a man of Concern
 - A. The scene on the ground in Jerusalem
 - B. The scene on the ground in the Church

The lost – Romans 9:1-3 The Church –Colossians 2:1

 We cannot continue to play church and think that we are going to be ok in these last days

II. Nehemiah was a man with a Burden

- A. The Answer from Jerusalem
 - Great distress, reproach, walls are broken down and the gates burned
- B. Reaction to the Answer
 - Sat down and wept and mourned
- C. How we must respond to the situation
 - We are responsible for our REACTION
 - We give great insight into our lives as believers and as leaders by how we react. This is especially true of leaders - Numbers 13,14 – 12 spies
 - Nehemiah responded with passion
 - He responded with his WHOLE HEART not halfway
 - His burden caused him to weep and mourn

When was the last time we wept over the condition of the church or our world?

Mark 6, Matthew 9, Acts 17 – Luke 18

** REMEMBER - OUR REACTION REVEALS OUR HEART**

III. Nehemiah was a man of Action

- Fasted
- A time in which we set aside our normal eating routine (or other routines) to seek God Ezra 8:21
- 2. Prayed
- O Why did Nehemiah pray??

Practical Application:

- How do you react to things in your life?
- Are you concerned for the church and the world?
- Does what you discover from your concern cause you to be burdened?
- When was the last time you shed tears in your pursuit of God's heart for the world?
- Do you make it a practice to seek God in fasting and prayer?
