I. Failure of the Fathers

1. Proud vs humility
 - Creates an attitude referred to in the OT as “stiff necked”

Globally

At least **450 Christians have died** in a series of attacks on Christian villages in three northcentral **Nigerian** states since May, according to reports from religious freedom advocates.

Tens of thousands were displaced, according to MSN and Christian Solidarity Worldwide. Whole villages, dozens of church buildings and thousands of homes reportedly were destroyed. Grain was looted. CT

Canadian Baptist Ministries (CBM):

"Pray especially for **Democratic Republic Congo** (DRC) where horrific violence has taken place outside the cameras and reporting of (global) media and where violence remains a constant threat."

CBM partners with churches who work in refugee camps and settlements in African, Middle East, and Asian countries. These partners work to provide people with support in entrepreneurial training, trauma counselling, helping vulnerable children (DR Congo), accessing education and medical supplies in Lebanon. *Pray that CBM's programs bring hope and peace to refugees.*
